<p>About the Project</p>	<p><b>Project background:</b> Currently, the digital wave is sweeping the world. With all countries' major push for development of information infrastructure and widespread use of the Internet, the active technical invocations of the new-era information communication technologies represented by 5G has speeded up the deep integration among all economic and social sectors, and increasingly become a key driver for digitization, networking and intelligent transformation and upgrading in the economic society. At present, more and more countries recognize the important role of new technologies such as 5G, cloud computing, and cyber security for digital economic transformation and national governance capacity. However, most developing countries and regions are mostly in the early stage of digital transformation, which are facing common threats such as network information security and high frequency of cyber security incidents. Due to the limitations of their own conditions, many countries have insufficient technology, funds and resources in 5G and cloud computing, so they need to carry out exchange and cooperation in developing cyberspace and 5G.</p> <p><b>Training purpose:</b> This seminar aims to strengthen the experience exchange in key technologies of 5G cyber security between China and the developing countries, to promote the competent ministries and senior managers in information technology to gain new knowledge in the digital transformation of 5G and cyberspace security, to understand the cutting-edge technologies and management models in the digital transformation of China's economy, and promote cooperation between China and relevant countries in the field of cyber security.</p>

	<p><b>Training content:</b> The seminar will mainly focus on the overview of China's national conditions, China's reform and opening up and the path to Chinese modernization, global development initiatives, a community with a shared future for mankind, the latest 5G technical standards and progress, application and development of the key 5G technology, the development trend of cyber security threats and risk management caused by new technologies, construction of new digital-oriented cyber security system and the historical review of network information attack and defense war, etc.</p> <p><b>Training method:</b> We sincerely invite experts in China's key 5G cyber security technology and related fields to give lectures for the officials according to the topic; organize exchanges between participants and experts, as well as between participants; organize field visits to relevant cyber security technology enterprises in Beijing and other cities.</p> <p>(The above is a preliminary schedule, which may be adjusted based on the actual situation. The final version will be provided after your arrival in China.)</p>

If participants cannot depart on time due to special circumstances, or if there is a flight delay during the transfer, please contact the Economic and Trade Office or the organizer in time, inform the latest flight No. and time of arrival in Beijing so that we can arrange pick-up for you.</li> <li>3. In principle, it is not allowed for individuals to change their tickets to China. If you really need to do so, please contact the Business Office and follow the procedures to change your ticket. Participants who change their tickets without consent will be notified to the Chinese embassy and the costs and responsibilities therefore incurred shall be borne by yourself.</li> <li>4.
