Seminar Content	<p>Project content: This program focuses on "Aviation Security" and covers various topics such as the basics of national aviation security crisis, national aviation security cases, development of aviation security crisis awareness, general basics of aviation security, airport security operations, airline security operations, security management and security monitoring. It also covers multimedia training systems for security check, standardized workflow of security check channels, basic maintenance of security check equipment and facilities, and the application of new security check technologies such as face recognition/fingerprint recognition. Furthermore, the program focuses on both theoretical lectures and case studies to help participants comprehend the significance of civil aviation security and prevention. It aims to educate individuals about the relevant security practices and enhance their aviation security capabilities in developing countries. During the training period, the Center will organize field trips to various cities in China, including Qionghai City, Wanning City, and Sanya City in Hainan Province, Shanghai Municipality, and Suzhou City in Jiangsu Province.
