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About the Organizer	<p>I.Implementing China-Aid training programs entrusted by major ministries and commissions including the Ministry of Commerce, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs, the Ministry of Education, and the China Overseas Chinese Association, we have accumulated rich experience in foreign affairs training.</p> <p>The implemented projects involve more than 170 countries, 7 languages and more than 10,000 trainees, with training topics covering Chinese language, culture, education, diplomacy, tourism, media and other fields.</p> <p>II.For more than 15 years, our college has organized nearly 170 China-Aid human resources training projects hosted by the Ministry of Commerce, accumulating rich experience in China-Aid training.</p> <p>The projects involve 139 countries, 7 languages and more than 5,000 government officials, with bilateral and multilateral projects, domestic and overseas projects, and project length ranging from 1 to 12 weeks. The training topics cover Chinese language, culture, education, diplomacy, tourism, media and other fields.</p> <p>III.Among the China-Aid projects, Chinese language and culture projects account for more than 80%, and we have accumulated profound experience in training Chinese culture projects. Up to now, our college has hosted 9 training programs for tourism officials, which has laid a solid foundation for hosting Seminar on Chinese Language &amp; Culture for Tourism Officials from Developing Countries again.</p>	

<p style="text-align: center;">Seminar Content</p>	<p>According to the set objectives, the seminar content consists of three main modules, including Lectures, Officials Visits &amp; Meetings and Discussions and Cultural Experience Activities.</p> <p>I. Lectures:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. China Basic Condition: mainly introduce the current political, economic, social and cultural development of China since the founding of New China 75 years ago and the reform and opening up 46 years ago, as well as the achievements made.</li> <li>2. China’s Development and “Belt &amp; Road” Initiative: introduce the “Belt &amp; Road” Initiative and the cooperation and exchange between China and developing countries.</li> <li>3. Strategies and Practices on Poverty Alleviation in China: introduce to poverty reduction in China, explaining the practice of poverty reduction in China from the perspective of political economy, and analyzing Chinese poverty reduction measures and correct experiences with examples.</li> <li>4. Applied Chinese: teach Chinese greetings and self-introduction phrases and learn how to read numbers and express time, do shopping and exchange currency.</li> <li>5. Chinese Tourism Culture: introduce various famous tourist attractions in China, while interpreting the Chinese cultural connotations behind the tourist attractions.</li> <li>6. Chinese Martial Arts: introduce the spiritual connotation of Chinese martial arts, let the participants master the basic knowledge of Chinese martial arts, understand the basic moves and essentials of martial arts, and experience martial arts performance first-hand.</li> <li>7. Chinese Culture of Peking Opera: through the introduction of Peking Opera, students will have a comprehensive understanding of Peking Opera and its related cultural knowledge, and feel the charm of the national essence.</li> <li>8. Chinese Festivals Culture: introduce Chinese traditional festivals, cultural customs, traditional festival foods and songs, etc.</li> <li>9. Chinese Paper-cutting Culture: through the training, students will understand the history and culture of Chinese paper-cutting and be able to complete paper-cutting works independently.</li> <li>10. Chinese Costume Culture: narrative around the development history of clothing, cultural phenomena, colors, shapes, techniques, materials, brands, etc. Through a more systematic introduction, the thematic content of the field of clothing culture is displayed.</li> </ol> <p>II. Officials Visits &amp; Meetings and Discussions:</p> <p>We will organize field trips to Beijing and Hangzhou to exchange with government agencies, enterprises and institutions in different fields, so that participants can experience China’s development first-hand and gain an in-depth understanding of China's development model and experience.</p> <p>III. Cultural Experience Activities:</p> <p>In addition to the lectures and exchanges, we will also organize visits to famous historical and cultural sites in Beijing and Hangzhou, so that the participants can experience first-hand the profoundness of Chinese culture and social development.</p> <p>We hope, through this seminar, the participants will not only experience Chinese language and culture, but also know more about China, so as to promote the cooperation between China and Developing Countries and lay a solid foundation for further exchanges and cooperation.</p>
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
