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About the Organizer	<p>The International Poverty Reduction Center in China (IPRCC) was established in May 2005 as one of outcomes of Shanghai Global Conference on Scaling Up Poverty Reduction in 2004. IPRCC was jointly initiated and established by the Chinese government, the UNDP, the World Bank and other international organizations. It is designed for research, training, exchange, collaboration and knowledge sharing in poverty reduction. IPRCC is committed to the internationalization of China's poverty reduction experience, as well as the localization of global experience, so as to forge an integrated platform for poverty reduction and development. Since 2005 to the end of 2023, IPRCC has successfully held 201 seminars, with 5477 participants from 140 countries. IPRCC has developed training textbooks such as "Ten Keys to Understanding China's Poverty Reduction", video textbooks and micro video cases teaching materials. In the central and western regions in China, 15 provinces have been identified as "China Poverty Alleviation Exchange Base". Participants can be arranged to visit the bases for field visits and feel the effects of poverty alleviation policies and practices. IPRCC is also equipped with an international training team that understands business, knows foreign languages and has high quality. At the same time, it has compiled and printed the international training manual for poverty reduction, which has strengthened the standardized management and promoted the high-quality development of project implementation. <p style="text-align: center;">Seminar Content</p>	<p>The theme of this seminar is "Formulation and Implementation of Poverty Reduction Planning", recalling that the economic and social development history of the People's Republic of China in the past 75 years is a history of poverty reduction with Chinese characteristics, and it is also a vivid example of a specific developing country's efforts to fully eliminate absolute poverty through continuous formulation and implementation of poverty reduction planning: In 1949, at the beginning of the founding of the People's Republic of China, China established a basic socialist social system conducive to poverty reduction, so that the basic needs of the Chinese people, especially farmers, were initially met. In 1978, the reform and opening up vigorously liberated and developed productive forces, and promoted and accelerated large-scale poverty reduction through economic development; In 1986, the Poverty Alleviation Office of the State Council was established; In 1993, the state formulated and implemented the 8-7 Poverty Alleviation Plan, ushering China into a new era of poverty alleviation and development. In 2001 and 2010, The State Council twice issued the ten-year Program for Poverty Alleviation and Development, which implemented the participatory "whole village promotion" of poverty alleviation, consolidated the achievements of food and clothing, and accelerated poverty alleviation and prosperity. In 2013, the 18th National Congress of the Communist Party of China further clarified that by 2020, we will win the battle against poverty and finish building a moderately prosperous society in all respects. In response to the actual needs of developing countries in formulating rural development and poverty reduction plans and implementation models, the seminar invited government officials and researchers from relevant departments of agriculture and rural areas, poverty reduction, economy, employment, ecology, education, finance, finance, public services, planning and development, and international cooperation in developing countries to introduce China's formulation and implementation of poverty reduction planning. To comprehensively implement the strategic planning, policy formulation and implementation experience of poverty alleviation and development, winning the battle against poverty, and continuously promoting rural revitalization, and conduct in-depth discussions on the formulation and implementation models of poverty reduction planning in developing countries, so as to improve the ability of officials in developing countries to formulate and implement policies and plans related to rural development and poverty reduction. The teaching activities of the workshop are divided into three parts: Thematic lecture, discussion and exchange and field visit.</p> <p>I. Thematic Lecture. It includes 1 public course and 9 core courses. The lecture covers the planning and implementation of a series of rural development and poverty reduction policies with Chinese characteristics, including China's economic and social development, formulation and implementation of poverty reduction planning, rural poverty alleviation, industrial poverty alleviation, employment poverty alleviation, education poverty alleviation, health poverty alleviation, ecological poverty alleviation, and financial poverty alleviation.</p> <p>1. Public Curriculum: Strategy and Effectiveness of China's Economic and social development. It mainly introduces China's basic national conditions and the main results, strategic measures, models and mechanisms of economic and social development, as well as experience and inspiration.</p> <p>2. Core Courses:</p> <p>(1) Formulation and implementation of China's poverty reduction planning. This course mainly introduces the formulation of China's rural poverty reduction strategic plans, policy measures, implementation mode and experience enlightenment.</p> <p>(2) Policy formulation and practical effects of China's industrial poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy practice, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's industrial poverty alleviation.</p> <p>(3) Policy formulation and practical effects of China's employment poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy practice, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's employment poverty alleviation.</p> <p>(4) Policy formulation and practical effects of China's rural education poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy practice, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's education poverty alleviation.</p> <p>(5) Policy formulation and practical effects of China's rural health poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy practice, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's health poverty alleviation.</p> <p>(6) Policy formulation and practical effects of China's science and technology poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy practice, main</p>
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effects and experience enlightenment of China's science and technology poverty alleviation.
(7)Policy formulation and practical effects of China's ecological poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy practice, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's ecological construction and green development.

(8)Policy formulation and practical effects of China's financial poverty alleviation. This course mainly introduces the strategic framework, policy measures, main effects and experience enlightenment of China's financial poverty alleviation.

(9)The policy formulation and implementation achievement of poverty alleviation policies by local provinces and regions. This course mainly introduces the policy formulation of poverty alleviation planning, policies and measures, implementation mode and experience and inspiration of local provinces and regions.
