About the Organizer	Jiangsu Institute of Parasitic Diseases (JIPD), founded in July 1950, is located in Meiyuan, Wuxi – a natural scenic zone on Tai Lake, which is regarded as one of the most beautiful cities in China. The institute is one of the most advanced institutes in the field of malaria and other parasitic diseases control in the country, The institute offers Master degree since 1979 with approval by National Degree Committee, State Council. JIPD has an expert team with rich experience of malaria control, leading by Professor Gao Qi, consists of many professors with overseas education and working experiences. As the technical consultant of malaria by WHO, committee member of vector-borne diseases of United Nations Environment Program (UNEP)/WHO and former director of Advisory Committee on Malaria, Ministry of health, China, Professor Gao Qi has been to African countries many times for technical training and inspection, assigned by Ministry of Foreign Affairs, Ministry of Commerce and Ministry of Health. The training course for experts in 30 Chinese-aid anti-malaria Centre was held by JIPD. Since 2002, multiple international training courses or workshops of malaria entrusted by Ministry of Commerce have been held in JIPD every year. JIPD composed of Department of Schistosomiasis Control, Department of Malaria Control, Department of Filariasis & Intestinal Helminthiasis, Research Department, Editorial Office, Training Centre, Health Examination Centre and Clinic Service, Key Laboratory on Technology for Parasitic Disease Prevention and Control, Ministry of Health. It equipped with conference building, boarding rooms and entertainment rooms is in a beautiful campus of the institute. Falling into the subtropical monsoon climate belt, Wuxi is characterized by four distinct seasons. Average temperature in May is about 25°C.				

This seminar consists of two parts: a series of lectures on special topics and visits to other cities in China. The topic of the first parts contain basic knowledge of malaria, Chinese experience in the prevention and control of malaria, national malaria elimination program in China, strategy for vector control, principle and proposal for new anti-malarial drugs, progress on malaria vaccine and diagnosis, international cooperation on malaria, etc.

Participants will have opportunity to visit the Chinese Center for Disease Control and Prevention to better understand the system of prevention and control of malaria in China, and share experiences of fight against and elimination of malaria. At the same time, participants will learn about the establishment of surveillance system after the elimination of malaria in China and the prevention and control experience of other tropical diseases.

In addition to these official activities, the seminar will also arrange the participants to carry out urban cultural experience and exchange activities in their spare time, feel the Chinese culture and customs, and help the participants to understand the time-honored Chinese culture. Through the training, the participants will have a more comprehensive understanding of China and China's parasitic diseases situation, especially preventive control strategies and technical methods on malaria. It provides reference for their own national disease prevention and control. These are all good foundations for further exchanges and cooperation between China and developing countries in disease prevention and control.
