# 2. Brief introduction of foreign aid work:

ICC makes full use of the advantages of relevant departments and bureaus of the National Development and Reform Commission and the Academy of Macroeconomic Research. Over the years, a large number of experts have been gathered to make great contributions to recipient countries in terms of economic policy interpretation, planning formulation, and international cooperation. As of the end of 2023, ICC has implemented more than 400 foreign aid training programs. It has invited nearly 20,000 officials from more than 130 countries and regions on six continents. There are more than 20 themes, mainly covering the construction of the "Belt and Road", macroeconomics, infrastructure, urbanization, China's experience sharing, governance, public management, capacity cooperation, climate change, medium and long-term planning. Over the years, ICC has organized and implemented 44 projects under the "Belt and Road" initiative, training more than 1600 officials from countries along the route. ICC has made great efforts to publicizing the "Belt and Road" initiative, interpreting Chinese policies and measures, sharing development experiences, and promoting people-to-people bonds in countries along the route.

### 3. Overview of the executive team:

ICC has more than 30 professional and executive staffs for foreign aid training project, who have participated in foreign aid training and related international cooperation projects for many years, including 6 members with more than 8 years of foreign aid training experience and 7 members with more than 6 years of foreign aid training experience. There are 6 members with 5 years of foreign aid training experience, and more than 11 members with 4 years or less of foreign aid training experience. Their working languages involve English, French, Spanish, and Russian. Among them, 8 people has passed the TEM-8 and 7 have returned from studying abroad with rich experience in foreign affairs and international cooperation. Meanwhile, other research teams of ICC can also participate in the work of foreign aid training projects to ensure the successful implementation of the project.

The formulation and implementation of medium- and long-term development plans and programmes in science and technology at a national strategic level during a specific period of development opportunity has a significant impact on a country's scientific and technological development, as well as its economic and social development. On the basis of "Belt and Road", China has aligned itself with the United Nations 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development, and is endeavouring to eliminate the root causes of and obstacles to development by taking the path of coordinated economic, social and environmental development. We will enhance the endogenous momentum of the co-construction countries to achieve lasting, inclusive and sustainable economic growth, and integrate the concept of sustainable development into all aspects of project selection, implementation and management.

Through this training, we will share China's experience in the preparation of medium- and long-term planning with officials from various developing countries, exchange the difficulties and challenges encountered by developing countries in the process of preparing medium- and long-term development plans, further strengthen the exchanges and cooperation among relevant departments of various countries, promote learning and exchanges among enterprises of various countries, and actively promote the in-depth development of relations among various countries. In addition to the rich programme, we will also take the participants to visit Hangzhou and Wuxi, two representative cities in China. Hangzhou is the economic, cultural, scientific and educational centre of Zhejiang Province and one of the central cities of the Yangtze River Delta, with many humanistic monuments. Wuxi is a prefecture-level city under the jurisdiction of Jiangsu Province and one of the central cities of the Yangtze River Delta, a national historical and cultural city of China, as well as the cradle of China's national and township industries. The in-depth investigation of the current situation of local development in the city and the talks and exchanges with local enterprises will help the participants to further understand China's regional development strategy and accurately match the needs of pragmatic cooperation.
