Seminar Content This seminar combines training sessions, discussion sessions, and field visits. Participants are going to visit Beijing. As the capital city of China and an international metropolis, Beijing is the political and cultural center of China. In Beijing, participants shall visit Beijing Phoenix TV, China Film and Television Base, China Media Museum, and other places. The seminar is to be held in Qingdao, which is a nationally designated city and an important coastal city. It is also the host city for major international events such as the Olympic Sailing Competition and the Shanghai Cooperation Organization Summit, as well as political and economic summits. Participants shall visit Qingdao Television Station, Peninsula Metropolitan Daily, Qingdao News Network and other institutions. Discussions and exchanges are to be held during the visits.

This seminar aims to provide participants with an understanding of China's experience and practice in news and media and opportunities of capability building for officials and journalists from national news agencies among the "Belt and Road" countries. The seminar aims to promote exchanges and friendly relations between China and other developing countries in the field of news media.
