About the Organizer	<p>CTC was established in 2005, located in Taicang City, Jiangsu Province. It is a public institution directly under the National Health Commission, and it is also the China Programme Office of Partnership in Population and Development, and one of the foreign-aid training institutions of the Ministry of Commerce. Since its establishment for 16 years, CTC has played a window role in international and domestic exchanges and cooperation, and achieved good results.</p> <p>1.CTC organized 41 foreign-aid training seminars, providing training in reproductive health, maternal and child healthcare, population development and poverty alleviation for 1136 government officials, experts, scholars and technicians from more than 70 developing countries, including 89 ministerial level officials and 176 bureau level officials.</p> <p>2.CTC organized 42 international exchange activities in the field of South-South Cooperation. It has provided services to 1765 official representatives from PPD member countries, UN Population Fund and other non-governmental organizations, and promoted knowledge dissemination, technology exchange and experience sharing of South-South Cooperation.</p> <p>CTC carried out 105 domestic training sessions, providing training for more than 10,000 participants. The training content involves the reform of public hospitals, the professional construction of hospital directors, maternal and child healthcare, reproductive health, and other topics in the field of health development. It provides an important guarantee for the implementation of relevant national policies, the improvement of health personnel quality, population health and social sustainable development.</p>	

<p>Seminar Content</p>	<p>Commissioned by the Ministry of Commerce of the People’s Republic of China (MOFCOM), China Training Center of Reproductive Health and Family Care (CTC) will hold the "Seminar on population and development for Developing Countries" in Taicang, Jiangsu Province from November 1 to November 14, 2023. The seminar will invite Chinese experts, scholars, and government officials in the field of population and development to share the updated information with the participants.</p> <p>This program is mainly arranged as follows: The training content consists of expert lectures, exchange discussions, visits, etc., Details show below:</p> <p>1. Lectures: Lectures are divided into two aspects: macro strategy discussion and achievement experience sharing. In terms of macro strategy, within the framework of the United Nations Millennium Development Goals and the Sustainable Development Goals, the seminar will review the latest progress and developments in the population aspect in the international community, make a macro introduction to the remarkable achievements and future challenges of China's population policy. In terms of achievement experience sharing, the seminar will mainly introduce and share China's experience and strategies in population policy.</p> <p>2. Exchange and Discussion: Based on the ideas learned in the training course and the national conditions of the countries where the trainees are located, discuss the relevant issues in the field of population that currently faced by developing countries, and seek common ideas to promote development.</p> <p>3. Visits and Inspections: The seminar will arrange attending officials to visit and inspect service institutions in the field of population (maternal and child health care, aging). Through on-site visits and exchanges, we can gain a more intuitive understanding of China's operation in the public service system for promoting population policy. In addition, the seminar will also arrange for officials to experience traditional Chinese culture, enabling them to have a more comprehensive understanding and experience of China's socio-economic development.</p>
