Training Content Introduction	<p>Focusing on the theme of “Livestock Breeding and Livestock Product Processing”, this training course will achieve the goal through lectures, exchanges and discussions, on-site teaching, field visits and activities.</p> <p>Module I, Lectures.</p> <p>1. Basic Courses</p> <p>(1) An Overview of China: Introduce China's political, economic, societal and cultural basics.</p> <p>(2) China's Agricultural Development Policy: Introduce China’s achievements in agricultural development, the policies and measures adopted in promoting agricultural development and their roles in China’s agricultural development.</p> <p>2. Specialized Courses</p> <p>(3) China’s Animal Husbandry Development Policies and Measures: Introduce China’s policies and measures in livestock breeding, feed management, livestock product processing, forage development, waste management, product quality and safety as well as grassland ecological protection. The theories and methods in animal husbandry development planning will also be touched. Courses include: “Overview of the Development of China’s Animal Husbandry”, “Introduction to China’s Animal Husbandry Industry Policies”, “Measures for the Scientific and Standardized Development of Rural Animal Husbandry” and etc.</p> <p>(4) Livestock Breeding and Management: Introduce animal genetics, breeding and production, animal nutrition and feed processing, feed preparation and quality analysis, environmental health and disease control of livestock, poultry breeding technology, cattle and sheep production technology, cattle raising and cattle disease prevention, sheep raising and sheep disease prevention and etc. Courses include: “The Application of Standardized Husbandry Technology in China”, “Standardized Cattle Breeding Technology”, “Standardized Sheep Breeding Technology”, “Standardized Livestock and Poultry Facilities Breeding Technology”, “Technical Specification for Standardized Livestock and Poultry Breeding” and etc.</p> <p>(5) Livestock Product Processing Technology: Introduce the technology adopted in livestock product processing, mainly focuses on the processing, storing and preserving technology of meat, egg and milk.</p>	

<p>Module II, Exchanges and discussions.</p> <p>(1) Participants exchange views on the current situation and development trend of animal husbandry in their own countries.</p> <p>(2) Participants exchange views on the current situation and existing problems of domestic livestock product processing industry.</p> <p>(3) Participants exchange and discuss views on the key points and cautions in designing farms of beef cattle, sheep, broiler and layer chicken.</p> <p>(4) Participants exchange learning experiences, discuss prospects of cooperation opportunities with China in livestock breeding and livestock product processing; summarizing the course.</p> <p>Module III, On-the-spot teaching and field visit.</p> <p>(1) Participants will visit some places of historical interest, like the Great Wall and the Forbidden City to learn about China’s history and culture. Besides, they will visit the National Agricultural Exhibition Center (China Agricultural Museum) to understand agricultural history and culture, appreciate the charm of farming culture.</p> <p>(2) Participants will go to Xinjiang Uygur Autonomous Region, which has great natural resources and good foundation in animal husbandry development in China for on-site teaching and field visit on breeding, processing, forage management, disease prevention and control of beef cattle, mutton sheep and dairy industry.</p> <p>(3) Participants will go to Tianjin for field visit on the development of modern livestock and poultry breeding industry, focusing on the site visiting of breeding and processing of broilers, layer hens and other livestock varieties.</p> <p>Materials needed to be prepared by participants</p> <p>In order to facilitate the communication with experts and participants from China and other countries, please prepare in advance the materials related to the topics in the participants’ home countries, such as: ① Introduction of their majors, occupations and organizations; ② Presentation on the animal husbandry development of their home countries; ③ The status quo, problems and future plans of the livestock breeding and product processing in their countries; ④ The basis and expectations of cooperation with China; And others.</p>
