- 1. Member States are advised that the Government of Chile has informed of the opening of the International Course II Post Graduate Diploma in Management, Engineering and Science for Disaster Resilience, 18 November to 6 December 2019, Santiago, Chile
- 2. All Member States are invited to submit nominations of suitably qualified citizens.
- 3. The course will be conducted in Spanish. Applicants must meet the following requirements:
 - (i) Be proficient in the Spanish language;
 - (ii) Have a University Degree in Engineering, Public Administration, Science or Management;

- (iii) Should be a public official with a managerial and decision making profile in the area of disaster risk reduction and must have at least two years of experience working with projects related to the risks of socio natural disasters;
- (iv) Actors of the private sector that participate in the management of emergencies and the reduction of disaster risks;
- (v) Be a citizen and resident in a CARICOM country;
- (vi) Should be nominated by the employing Institution;
- (vii) Have good physical and mental health compatible with the activities of the Diploma Course.
- 4. Member States are asked to note that the deadline for submission of applications to the focal point at the Embassy of Chile is **Friday**, **2 August 2019**. Focal points in each country may have a different deadline. Member States are asked to consult with the Focal Points.
- 5. Applications for the Scholarship should be sent in both paper and electronic formats to the focal point in each country. Applications must include the following documents:
 - (i) Application Form signed by both the candidate and the Head of the employing Institution;
 - (ii) Letter of Acceptance to the Programme from the University of Chile;
 - (iii) Initial Project Report;
 - (iv) Letter of Commitment;
 - (v) Letter of Institutional Commitment;
 - (vi) Work Certificate;
 - (vii) Non-Spanish-speaking applicants must submit a language management accreditation.
- 6. Successful applicants will be provided with the following:
 - (i) Tuition and programme fees;
 - (ii) Airline ticket to and from the country of origin and Santiago;
 - (iii) Transport from the hotel to the airport (return);
